

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

Directions:

From Augusta take Hwy 25 into Waynesboro. In Waynesboro pick up Hwy 24 heading towards Sardis. Go all the way into Sardis on Hwy 24. In Sardis stay on Hwy 24 until you pass the intersection with Hwy 23. Shortly after this intersection look for Ellison Bridge Road on your left. Take a left onto Ellison Bridge Road and continue for one mile. Turn left onto Johnson Road. Look for Georgia Land Sales LLC signs on your left. Property fronts on Johnson Road with a driveway that leads into the property.

Restrictions:
